Every Friday, during term time, Giggles & Wiggles meet at 9.30 - 10.45am and aims to provide a safe and welcoming space for parents and carers of pre-school children.

Giggles & Wiggles is very popular and is usually full. Bookings open at 7am on the Wednesday morning and spaces are usually filled by lunchtime on the same day! New people come, like what they see and return the next week, often bringing a friend with them.

Since moving back into the re-decorated hall, we have made a few changes to the activities we provide, including messy play opportunities, which have been well received. This may consist of toys in sand, rice, pasta, oats, lentils or ice. Each week we offer 2 different activities in the tuff trays and offer a craft activity three times a term.

Unfortunately this does make clearing away a bit more of a challenge and we would like to take this opportunity to apologise for any grains of rice or sand that manages to find its way into the church - it's amazing how far it can travel with the help of excitable toddlers!

The children are also able to play with trains, cars, jigsaws, play doh and a colouring activity each week, as well as classic favourites including a slide, ride on cars, a home corner and a book corner.

We have a very small, dedicated team and can only run these sessions with their support. This includes John & Ian, who take it in turns to set up the space before each session; Jennifer, Lou and Linda who faithfully take turns leading the time of singing at the end of each session which is enjoyed by all; Linda, Sarah & Judith who bake behind the scenes so the adults can always enjoy a homemade slice of cake.

Then of course are our regular session helpers; Ceri, Margaret, Audrey and Daph, who all sign up on a rota, to provide the warm welcome, a listening ear and a cup of tea / coffee to all who come. Thank you to all of our brilliant team for your hard work, commitment and support.

We are so proud of the excellent reputation G&W has built up in Newbury over many years, and the service we are able to provide to members of our local community.

However, this can only continue with the support of our church family. So if you could spare a couple of hours on a Friday morning to become a part of our team, we would love to hear from you.

Prayers for Gaza and the West Bank

- Pray that amid all the restrictions and difficulties, the Arab Israeli Church would find a way to reach Gaza and offer help to its suffering people.
- Please pray that any humanitarian aid sent to Gaza would reach trustworthy hands and not be stolen and be distributed wisely and fairly to those in need.
- Please lift up all Arab Christians in Israel and pray that we would resist hatred and instead become a living bridge of reconciliation between peoples.
